“One Day Workshop on Provisions of New Juvenile Justice Care and Protection Act, 2015 and RTE Act, 2009 for running of Children Homes and Hostels”

Applications are invited from NGOs/CSOs engaged in running Homes/Hostels for children for a “One Day Workshop on Provisions of Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection) Act, 2015 and Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009 for running of Children Homes and Hostels”. The workshop is being organised by National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) in collaboration with Assam State Commission for Protection of Child Rights (ASCPCR).

1. Objective of the Workshop

To sensitize administrative/non-administrative staff of any/all organisations involved in running of Children Homes & Hostels regarding the provisions of the J.J. Act 2015 and its Rules, and Provisions and Entitlements as laid down under the RTE Act, 2009, thereby sensitising them to preserve the rights of children as per the J.J. Act, 2015.

2. Participants

- Participants of these sensitisation workshops shall be representatives of various Children Homes and Hostels run by NGOs, CSOs any other individuals.
- Total 100 participants shall be invited for this one day workshop.
- Maximum two (2) participants should be nominated by each organisation.
- The organisations running Children Home/Hostel shall be chosen by NCPCR and Assam SCPCR.

3. Venue

Venue shall be communicated to the shortlisted participating organisations.

4. Expected Outcome

Generating awareness and sensitizing administrative/non-administrative personnel and staff of any/all organisations regarding the provisions of the J.J. Act, 2015; its Rules and Provisions & Entitlements as laid down RTE Act, 2009 who are involved in running Children Homes/Hostels

5. Date

This workshop shall be held on 9th January 2017 in Guwahati, Assam. The program schedule and venue of the workshop shall be communicated to the selected organisation/s separately.

6. Local Transport/TA


NCPCR shall bear TA for local transport of the participants on submission of original receipt/voucher/bill of the local TA claimed.


